Available to book only for the spring and summer of 2020, this package grants you three nights' exclusive use of the place—which features 13 suites, for a maximum of 20 guests—as well as personal chef services by Chef Mads Refslund, co-founder of the much-lauded, Michelin star-awarded Noma in Copenhagen. Working with a resident nutritionist, Chef Mads will craft three balanced, flavorful menus a day drawing upon hyper-seasonal ingredients, in keeping with Shou Sugi Ban House's "food is medicine" philosophy. *Starting at \$130,000.*
