



RECOMMENDED LOCAL ATTRACTIONS AND ACTIVITIES

WATERMILL

PARRISH ART MUSEUM

The Parrish Art Museum, designed by Herzog & de Meuron Architects, focuses extensively on work by artists from the artist colony of the South and North Shores. The Parrish is adjacent to Shou Sugi Ban House and SSBH guests receive complimentary entry. Please contact your retreat host for admission.

THE WATERMILL CENTER

The Watermill Center is a laboratory for the arts and humanities founded in 1992 by visual artist and theater director Robert Wilson.

CLAY ART GUILD OF THE HAMPTONS

The Clay Art Guild of the Hamptons is a creative community devoted to teaching clay art, exhibiting clay art and providing an environment for the enrichment of clay artists. The Guild offers classes and workshops held in the former Celadon Gallery in Water Mill.

THE GREEN THUMB

Visit this third-generation family-run farmstead offering the highest quality certified organic produce and plants. Stock up on a wide selection of local items, snacks and beverages to return home with.

SOUTHAMPTON ART CENTER

The Southampton Arts Center offers broad programming delivered year-round through an impressive array of partners including the New York Academy of Art, Hamptons International Film Festival, Jazz at Lincoln Center, Telluride's Mountainfilm, the Watermill Center and many more.

EAST END FOOD INSTITUTE

East End Food Institute is a non-profit membership organization comprised of farmers, food producers and food consumers on the East End of Long Island. The kitchen hosts frequent events including cooking demonstrations and "lunch and learn" workshops.

SOUTHAMPTON FARMERS MARKET

The Southampton Farmers Market is held every Sunday from 9:00AM - 2:00PM from late May until mid-October at 25 Jobs Lane (next to the Southampton Art Center) in the heart of Southampton Village. The market brings together an everchanging collection of local farmers and vendors selling freshly picked vegetables alongside handmade bags and garments.

SAG HARBOR

ELIZABETH A. MORTON NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE

A 1.4 mile trail loop with exceptionally diverse habitats including beaches and bluffs overlooking the bays, forests, fields, ponds, and a lagoon. These habitats are used by a variety of wildlife including white-tailed deer, Eastern Chipmunks, painted turtles, green frogs, songbirds, and osprey. Waterfowl, such as long-tailed duck, common goldeneye and white-winged scoter, are common during the winter months, while piping plovers, terns, and other water birds use the beach during the spring and summer months.

EMMA ROSE ELLISTON PARK

A 2.4 mile trail loop on the shore of Big Fresh Pond features a short hiking trail through native plants and trees and a footbridge over a stream. The town board accepted the memorial park as a donation from the Elliston family in 1952. It was deeded to the residents of Southampton Town to be preserved in its native state and condition as a bird and wildlife sanctuary.

THE CHURCH

The Church is a nonprofit arts center, founded by the artists Eric Fischl and April Gornik, with a mission to foster creativity on the East End and honor the living history of this quaint whaling village.

SAG HARBOR CINEMA

For over a century this theatre has been a landmark in the lively and culturally diverse Main Street district of Sag Harbor. The cinema shows primarily independent, foreign language, art-house, and documentary films.

BAY STREET THEATRE

A year-round performing arts space hosting mainstage productions, as well as a comedy club, workshops, special events, and educational outreach initiatives.

BRIDGEHAMPTON

CHANNING DAUGHTERS WINERY

A quaint winery and tasting room offering over two-dozen wine varieties. Established and run by local growers and creators on twenty-eight acres of land in Bridgehampton.

LONG POND GREENBELT TRAIL

A 3.8 mile trail loop encompassing a 1,100-acre area of interconnected ponds, woods, and wetlands. Spectacular for its wealth of rare plants, animals, and ecological communities, the Greenbelt is widely recognized as one of the most ecologically significant areas in all of New York State.

SAGAPONACK

WÖLFFER ESTATE VINEYARD

A sustainably-farmed vineyard since 1988 and now a local favorite, this tasting room offers flights, food, and sprawling views as well as a nearby wine stand that offers local varieties and breathtaking sunsets.

SAGAPONACK FARM DISTILLERY

This distillery is located in a 100-year-old retired dairy barn. Enjoy samples of Foster Farm's own potato and wheat spirits cultivated by siblings, Dean and Marilee Foster, whose family has tended to this 150 acres of land for over six generations.

MADOO CONSERVANCY

This public garden was established in 1967 by artist, gardener, and writer Robert Dash. Enjoy historic structures and diverse horticulture.

EAST HAMPTON

LONGHOUSE RESERVE

A sixteen-acre garden in East Hampton with established lawns, ornamental borders, plant collections, and outdoor sculptures. Rotating exhibitions are featured alongside permanent works from the likes of Ai Weiwei, John Giorno and Bernar Venet.

CEDAR POINT COUNTY PARK

Settled in 1651, Cedar Point was once a busy port for shipping farm goods, fish, and timber from Sag Harbor. Today, it offers 3.0 or 5.3 mile trail loops spanning the 600+ acres, including commanding views of Gardiner's Bay. Here you can find the historic Cedar Point Lighthouse, which was built in 1860. Its beacon served to guide whaling ships in and out of Sag Harbor during its heyday as a major port. The hurricane of 1938 altered the shoreline, creating a narrow strip that now connects the lighthouse with the mainland for pedestrians.

GUILD HALL

Guild Hall is an established cultural complex hosting art exhibits, theater, film series, concerts, and workshops.
